K - 8th Grade P.E. Requirements and Information

GRADE GRADING SCALE

Positive Individual Effort: 60%
(Daily Participation & Attitude)
Skill Evaluation 10%
Preparedness for Class: 30%

CLASS ACTIVITIES

The first 10 minutes are devoted to attendance, warm-ups, stretches and jogging. The remainder of the time will consist of instruction and participation of sports-related activities and cool down. All students will participate in the Annual Jog-a-thon in October and the 6th-8th grades will participate in the Tuolumne County Track Meet in May.

CLASS EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to put forth their best effort while encouraging others to do the same. Students working together with positive reinforcement and accepting of individual differences ensures every student has a positive P.E. experience.

- INJURIES must be reported to the teacher immediately.
- LOCKER ROOMS are off limits this year due to construction.
- CHANGE TIMES - Students must use their lunch hour or break to change into appropriate PE attire.

GRADING SYSTEM (10 points/day)

60% - INDIVIDUAL EFFORT/PARTICIPATION/ATTITUDE

- Grades are based on the student's effort observed throughout the quarter
- Students are expected to participate daily with a positive and encouraging attitude in class

10% - SKILL EVALUATIONS

- Grades are based on observed skill acquisitions, practice and application

30% - PREPAREDNESS FOR CLASS

(6th, 7th and 8th grade students will have uniforms and can change during lunch and after class)

- All K- 8th grade students are expected to wear appropriate athletic clothing on P.E. days
- Lace up or velcro shoes are required....NO sandals, heels, hard soled shoes or boots
- Lack of being properly dressed and ready for class will result in a **0%** for their class preparation grade

*Students will have an opportunity to makeup points lost on Tuesday's, Wednesday's and Thursday's at lunch recess when Coach Wright is present. Each lunch recess can makeup a maximum of 5 points.

EXCUSED PARTICIPATION

Students bringing a note excusing them from P.E. from a parent or guardian should include date, reason for excuse, and include what the student **CAN** do. Students excused from P.E. for more than 3 classes in a quarter grading period will receive a written assignment related to P.E. at the beginning of the class and is to be turned in at the end of the class. If a student becomes ill or injured at school or has forgotten a written excuse, participation will be excused for that day and the student will have to bring a note the next P.E. class or the student will receive **0%** for their preparation grade **AND** participation grade for the previous P.E. class.

Students who are instructed by their doctor **NOT** to participate in P.E. will be required to present a doctor's note indicating what the student **CAN** do, such as walk. Before being allowed to start participating in P.E. again, the student must present a doctor's note stating the student is cleared for P.E. activities. Any student who is unable to participate in P.E. will be ineligible for participation in any after school athletic activities.
