GENERAL POLICIES AGREEMENT

The following policies are described in more detail in the Parent-Student Handbook along with the full MLCS discipline policy. Please familiarize yourself with the full handbook when you receive it.

Dress Code: Our MLCS dress code is to promote modesty, manners, neatness, and safety. The scriptures exhort us to be *in the world but not of it*. Our desire to become like Jesus must be greater than the desire to act like the world, talk like the world, and/or dress like the world. At MLCS, the following guidelines are for grades K-8:

- Boys and girls are to remove hats inside all buildings; knit caps are okay.
- Flip-flops, high heel shoes, and shoes without heels (including Crocs) are not allowed (unsafe)
- Clothing, including jeans, must be without holes, frays, or rips.
- Shorts or leggings must be worn under all skirts or dresses that are above the knees.
- No tight-fitting legwear (yoga pants, leggings, jeggings, etc.) unless covered by dresses/shorts/skirts.
- Use of light make-up is reserved for only 7th & 8th grade girls.
- No cotton sweats or pajamas.
- The following are considered inappropriate for MLCS attire:
 - a. *All <u>short</u> shorts, <u>short</u> skirts, or <u>short</u> dresses.* Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be longer than the fingertips when the arms are straight down at the side.
 - b. Shirts and dresses with less than a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch wide shoulder strap.
 - c. Any clothing that exposes the belly or back (i.e. halter tops and racerback tanks)
 - d. Clothing with offensive language or logos.
 - e. Clothing that reveals undergarments (saggy pants/shorts; see through clothing)

Students who disrespect our MLCS dress code will be sent to the principal's office. Appropriate attire will be found in the thrift store if needed. Parents will be contacted for repeat offenses. Parent Initial Student Initial Student Phone Use: Students are not permitted to have or use cell phones on campus during the school day. If it is necessary to bring a digital device to school, it must be checked into the office before school begins and picked up after school. Phone calls can be made from the school office at any time during the school day. Parent Initial _____ Student Initial Gum, Litter, Vandalism: Students are not permitted to chew gum on campus and are expected to clean up after themselves and respect school property. Students who damage school property will be responsible for its repair or replacement. Parent Initial _____ **Student Initial Drop-Off & Pick-Up:** Students must be dropped off in front of the steps of the office building each morning. Any students on campus from 7:30-7:45am must report to the cafeteria for supervision. Playground supervision begins at 7:45am. If your student arrives after 8:10am, they must report to the office for a late pass. Student(s) will only be released to their parent or authorized adult. Children who are picked up early must be signed out by the authorized adult in the school office and with identification readily available. Any children not picked up during the 3:05-3:20pm dismissal time will be checked into the office to wait for parents. A charge of \$5.00 per ten minutes will be charged after that time.
